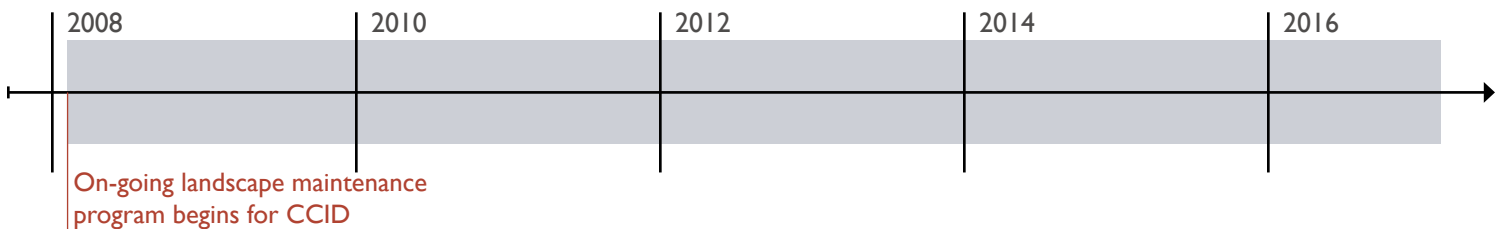


# Landscape Maintenance

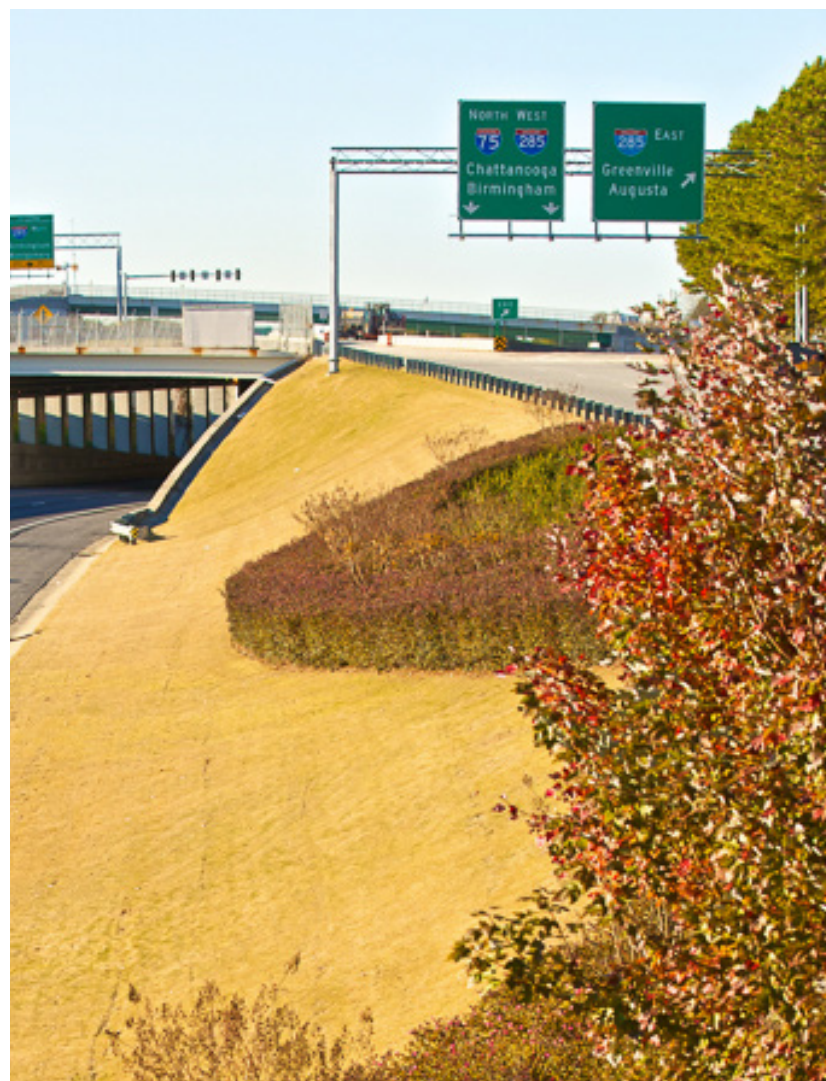
### CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE



### PROJECT OVERVIEW

The purpose of the Cumberland CID maintenance program is to provide a standard level of continuous care for the landscaping enhancements installed by the CID. Priority areas are “gateways” into the district, interchanges, and roadways with traffic counts of more than 10,000 cars per day.

- Removes approximately 37 tons of trash and litter on an annual basis
- Maintains medians and rights-of-way in high-traffic areas
- Maintains installed landscaping and pocket parks
- Maintains roughly 20 linear miles of roadway
- Designated clean-ups of the I-75/I-285 Clover Leaf and the Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area (CRNRA) Palisades Entrance



### FINANCIALS
